

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BURNING OF WASTE PAPER AND OTHER REFUSE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATING THEREOF:

The City Council of the City of New York Mills, Minnesota does ordain:

Section 1. No person shall set on fire or cause to be set on fire, any grass, hay, brush, excelsior, shavings, boxes, waste paper or other refuse or combustible material on his own property or that of another by means whereof the property of another, or any structure or other thing of value may be in danger without first having obtained permission from the City Services Department of City Clerk of the City of New York Mills.

Section 2. Any person convicted of any violation of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
