

ORDINANCE NO. 91

AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE TRANSIENT MERCHANTS
AND DEALERS, HAWKERS, PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS
AND CANVASSERS REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 77

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of New York Mills,
Minnesota, as follows:

Section I. No transient merchants and dealers, hawkers, peddlers, solicitors or canvassers, on foot or in a vehicle or others traveling through said City of New York Mills, shall sell, dispose of, offer for sale, vend or deliver any goods, wares or merchandise of whatever kind, or offer to perform any services for hire, solicit funds, or solicit inducement to enter contractual agreements for the purchase of good, wares or other services within the limits of said City without first having obtained a license therefore.

Section II. The City Council is hereby authorized, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated Section 412.221, Subd. 19, to grant such a license.

Section III. Every transient merchant, dealer, hawker, peddler, solicitor or canvasser shall apply for a license with the City Clerk and prior to conducting any business in the city, pay either a daily or annual fee according to eh following schedule:

- A. For each transient merchant, dealer, hawker, peddler, solicitor or canvasser traveling on foot, a daily fee of \$25.00 or an annual fee of \$100.00
- B. For each transient merchant, dealer, hawker, peddler, solicitor or canvasser traveling by vehicle, a daily fee of \$50.00 or an annual fee of \$200.00

Section IV. Said license is non-transferrable.

Section V. A violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of \$0-700.00 and/or 0-90 days in jail.

Section VI. This Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
